#### **Our writing needs to:**

Be well structured, with relevant ideas and format for the intended audience.

Contain a range of vocabulary.

Demonstrate an appropriate register; either formal or informal.

Demonstrate confident spellings.

Demonstrate effective punctuation and grammar.

Link directly to the task.

Achieve the intended purpose of the text and be appropriate for the specific audience.

Be clear and concise.

Be interesting and engaging for the reader.

Demonstrate correct use of subject specific terminology.

Be presented to the best of our ability.

Be creative or formative when necessary.

Be academic and demonstrate academic rigour when appropriate.
