

Use of itslearning at home

St Paul's use a learning platform called itslearning to support pupils with their learning at school and at home. On itslearning pupils have access to a course for each subject they study. In the event that pupils are expected to study from home, teaching staff will make additional resources available on itslearning.

Each course will have a resources tab and class teachers will prepare work in folders clearly labelled to enable pupils to identify the tasks they are due to complete. Teaching staff will send notifications and messages to ensure that pupils know what they are expected to do. Pupils will be able to contact teaching staff by the messaging option in the top right corner of itslearning. Please remember that staff will respond at the earliest opportunity.

Instructions will be shared with pupils to remind them how to access online work and message staff.

Accessing itslearning as a parent/guardian





Using itslearning to access Independent Learning

Once you have logged into itslearning, you should get the following options at the top (on a web browser):



To view Independent Learning, you will need to click on the 'Calendar' option. It is best to use the week view or the list view. If you have more than one child attending St Paul's you will be able to select one calendar at a time on the left hand side under the option 'Your Children'.



Independent learning will appear on the calendar on the date which it is due to be submitted to the teacher. This is to encourage pupils to plan ahead and also supports their use of the app and the calendar functionality. Each block on the calendar will have details regarding the independent learning task. You will need to click on the block for a description of the independent learning task.



On the top menu you are also able to select your child, under the option 'Your children' and you can view which courses they are a member of on itslearning. Parents have simplified access to itslearning and do not have access to individual resources, however we encourage pupils to show their parents or guardians the different resources available to them through their accounts.
