W/B 2nd March 2026	Successful applicants to St Paul's will be contact via post with a Welcome Letter and a letter inviting their child to Summer School (with details on how to sign your child up)	Welcome letter will include key dates, details on how to complete an electronic pupil information form, key points on use of buses, a link to uniform and equipment lists, induction day dates, and a link inviting prospective pupils to Summer School in August 2026.
W/B 2nd March 2026 – 5th June 2026	Transition visits begin	St Paul's staff will visit your child in their primary schools to talk about what it is like to belong to St Paul's Catholic School and to answer any questions they may have prior to induction day.
W/B 13th April 2026	Parent Questionnaire sent	An electronic questionnaire sent to obtain important information that will support the transition process for your child.
June 2026 (TBC)	Transition Plus session 9am – 12:45am	Invitation only event for pupils who will be joining our Emmaus department in school.
w/b 15th June 2026	Tutor group allocation and induction day information shared with parents/guardians via post.	Details on which tutor group your child has been allocated will be shared. Your child will have an allocated induction day shared with you on the letter as well as information regarding induction evening on 2 nd July 2026. Please note that is the parent/guardian's responsibility to inform their child's primary school of their allocated induction day.
30th June – 2nd July 2026	Induction Days for new intake	Pupils will be expected to be in school for 8:50am. The school day will end at 3:15pm.
2nd July 2026	Induction Evening 5:30pm- 8pm (MGR)	This is an opportunity for parents and pupils to meet key members of staff on a rotation to familiarise themselves with school expectations and procedures. There will be an opportunity to meet your child's form tutor and have a school tour.
25th and 26th August 2026	Summer School 10am – 2pm	Information regarding Summer School is available on our school's website. An invitation to attend is included in the Welcome Letter along with a link to an electronic consent form. Anyone requiring a paper copy will need to inform the school as soon as possible for this to be arranged.

4th September 2026	First day of school	Pupils will need to be in school for 8:50am and the school day will end at 3:35pm.
September 2026 (TBC)	Y7 Parent Information Evening	An evening led by the Y7 pastoral team to provide information on the year ahead.
September 2026 (TBC)	Meet the Tutor evening	An opportunity to meet with your child's form tutor to see how the first half term has gone.
23rd October 2026 – 9th November 2026	Parent Evaluation (electronic form)	This is an electronic form sent to all parents/guardians of Y7 pupils to provide an evaluation of the transition process based on their experience.
