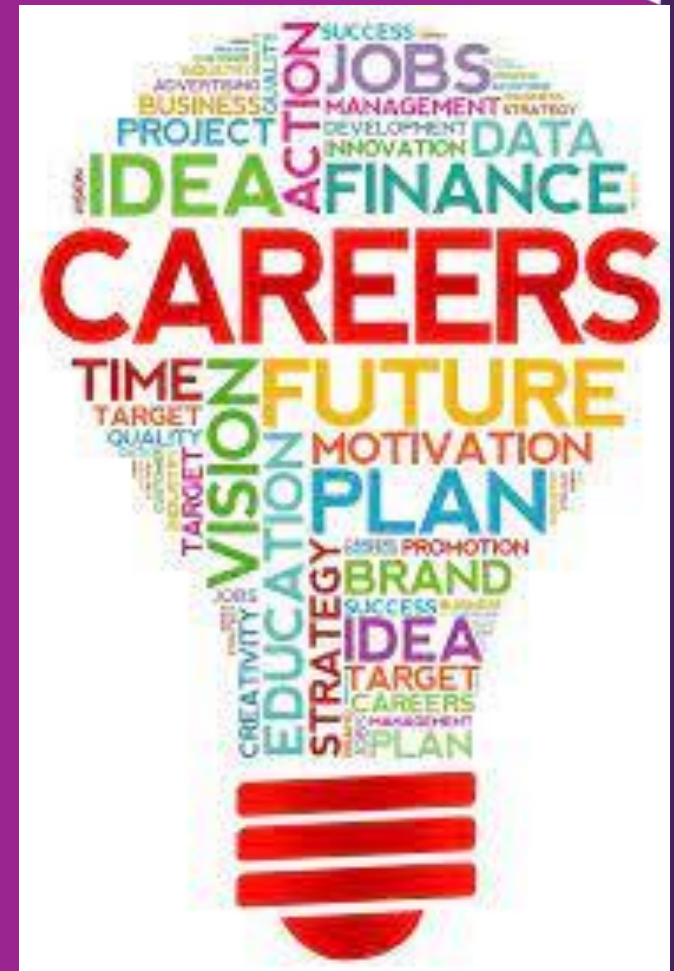

Hints and tips for
successfully
completing your
online application

- Do not rush to complete your application. Complete your research, think hard about your PPE grades, discuss with your parents/ caregivers.
- Ask questions to subject teachers, 6th Form Ambassadors and 6th Form staff.
- Your 6th Form subject choices should be a pathway into your future destination beyond school. Use Unifrog, the Careers Advisor and your own research to explore professions and careers, apprenticeships and university course options.



- Every question marked with a red asterisk * MUST be completed fully before the application can be submitted.
- **Subject Choices**
 - Maximum of 3 A-Levels or BTEC subjects ONLY.
 - Pathways: A-Level subjects, combination (A-Level subjects and BTEC courses), BTEC only courses.
 - Select a subject in 3 separate option blocks only.
 - Follow prompts if a subject choice instructs you to choose it in more than one option block.

Point score	Likely pathway
34 points and above	Minimum entry point for 3 A-levels & EPQ
28 to 33 points	Assessment of suitability through interview for the 3 A-level pathway or Blended BTEC/A-level pathway
24 to 27 points	Vocational Level 3
23 points and below	The Bridging Programme (one year)
